Dear Parents,

The Orleans After School Activities Program was established in 1991 to offer **working** families quality after school care for students attending school at OES who are in Kindergarten through 5th grade. Our 501(C) (3) Non-Profit status states clearly that a minimum of 85% of our enrolled students must be the children of gainfully employed parents/guardians or those currently seeking employment. Working families have priority for placement in the program and we will only place working families on our waitlist. We are currently licensed for 52 children per day.

We understand that the needs of kindergarten children and 5th graders differ greatly, and we run the program with this in mind. OASAP keeps a lower child to staff ratio than the state requires ensuring that the needs of all the children in our program are being met.

Tuition rates for 2024-2025

First Child	\$25 per day
Each additional child	\$21 per day

Please think about the days you will need, fill out the pre-registration form, enclose your fee of \$50.00 and return to the **OASAP office as soon as possible**. Kindergarten spaces are limited to the number of 5th graders leaving the program, and typically these spaces are taken before kindergarten screening. Please understand that by filling out this form your child is not guaranteed a slot in the program, I will inform you if we have a spot available or if we need to place on the wait list.

When you are signing up more than one child, please make sure that you put all names on the form. If your children will have different schedules, please ask for additional forms.

If you need to drop days from your schedule or be placed on the waitlist for extra days, please let us know over the summer by leaving a message at 508-255-0380 ext. 3105.
